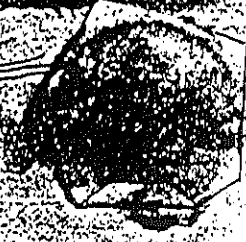


In the name of God Amen I John Woods of Derry township and

Woods and David Woods each to have an Equall part and they are to keep
their Mother and Give her a secret maintainance While she lives she is
likewise to have her bed and Cloths and any part of household furniture
she Chuses for her use the other third part of my Estate I Will to be divided
into six parts which I Will and bequeath to my Daughters and two Grand
Children that is to my Daughters Catharine and Jean and Elizabeth and
Marthens and Mary and to my Daughter anas two Children that is her son
John and her Daughters Jean my Daughter Mary is to have ten pounds
More to her part then her other Sisters the other five parts to be Equall
that is to Catharin Jean Elizabeth and Marthens and two ^{the wife of} Children above Named
is to have one part Equally Divided betwix them to be Given them when of
age or at the Discretion of my Executors likewise I Will and bequeath to my
Daughter Amer one Silver Doler and lastly I appoint my son John Woods
and Elipha Marson Whom I likewise constitute make and ordain the
Sole Executors of my last Will and Testament and I do hereby extoly
~~cancel~~ ~~revoke~~ and Disannul all and every other former Testaments Wills
or legacies and bequeaths to and Executors in any wise before named willed
and bequeathed rectified Confirming this and no other to be my last
